

## Agriculture in Kenya

- Kenya's agriculture sector directly influences overall economic performance through its contribution to GDP. Periods of high economic growth rates have been synonymous with increased agricultural growth. Major crops cultivation in Kenya affect African economy - tea, coffee, sugar, maize, horticulture, floriculture, cotton, macadamia nuts, etc.
- Kenya is a leading producer of tea and coffee, as well as third leading exporter of fresh produce, such as cabbage, onions and mangoes. Small farms grow most of the corn and also produce potatoes, beans and peas.
- Government will also focus on the 2030 agenda for sustainable development and its 17 sustainable development goals (SDGs) adopted by world leaders in 2015, to embody a roadmap for progress that is behind sustainable and leaves no one behind.
- The vision was developed through an all-inclusive stakeholder consultative process, involving Kenyans from all parts of the country. H.E. President Uhuru Kenyatta conceptualized "the Big 4 agenda" for various aspects including food & nutrition security, to accelerate the vision 2030. Under this Big 4 agenda, the government aimed to drive smallholder productivity, reduce the cost of food and enhance large scale farming & manufacturing; specifically on agro-processing where the government intends to generate over \$200 million annually in value additions.


